Immediately disconnect the affected machine from the network Take a snapshot of the affected systems state for later forensic analysis Do NOT pay the ransom

- 4 Eradication/Recovery** Once the threat is contained its time to remove it completely and restore systems to their preincident state This involves Malware removal Using antivirus software or specialized tools System restoration From backups ideally Regular tested backups are paramount Vulnerability patching Addressing the underlying weakness that allowed the breach
