the second international chromatiques whiteheadiennes conference was devoted exclusively to the exegesis and contextualization of whitehead s science and the modern world 1925 in order to elucidate the meaning and significance of this epoch making work the proceedings are designed to form companion volume with one paper devoted to each of its thirteen chapters the proceedings aim on the one hand to identify the specific contribution of each chapter to whitehead s own research program that is to say to put its categories into perspective by means of an internal analysis and on the other hand to identify its global impact in the history of ideas

a hundred years have now gone by since in the midsummer of 1882 pierre duhem a graduate of college stanislas completed with brilliant success his entrance exams to the ecole normale superieure and embarked on his career as a theoretical physicist his father a textile salesman

hoped that hierre would pursue a career in business one of the few professional fields where perhaps he would not have succeeded not that young duhem lacked sense for the practical he could have easily made a name for himself as an artist had he developed professionally his skill to draw portraits and landscapes his ability to make a point and his readiness to join in a debate could have earned him fame as a lawyer a potential actor was in sight when he entertained friends with mimicry that as a student of physics he entered and stayed first in his class at the ecole normale did not thwart his talents for the life sciences no less a biologist than pasteur tried to obtain duhem for assistant his command of greek and latin would have secured him a career as a classicist he was a frenchman not to be met too often whose rightful admiration for and mastery of his native tongue did not prove a barrier to the major modern languages as one who taught himself the complex art of medieval paleo graphy he could easily have mastered the many auxiliary sciences needed by a consummate historian

the present volume highlights the new challenges of the international protection of refugees fifty years after the adoption of the 1951 geneva convention relating to the status of refugees focusing on the problems faced by switzerland in the field of international protection of refugees as well as on the specificity of its asylum law and practice this publication addresses the refugee problem from a national european and international perspective the swiss experience serves to illustrate the wider problematic of on the one hand the tensions between security political and humanitarian concerns encountered by refugee receiving states and on the other the need to preserve an international refugee protection regime which remains an essential component of international law and relations for so long as political solutions are not brought to the root causes of refugee exodus this reflection on the international protection of refugees is organized around four main themes the first examines switzerland s response in the past to mass influx in the light of historical case studies and the evolution of swiss asylum law and practice the second focuses on the question of access of refugees to asylum territories and refugee status determination procedures within the framework of the 1951 convention on the status of refugees and the current swiss asylum law the third centres on the wider protection regime currently being forged in europe to address a broader category of refugees including solutions for temporary and subsidiary protection the final theme revolves around return of refugees including those under the dayton and recent kosovo agreements and covers reintegration of returnees assistance and long term development this work is based on papers presented at a colloquium of the graduate institute of the international studies in geneva which was organised in collaboration with the office of the united nations high commissioner for refugees as a contribution to the 50th anniversaries of the unhcr and the geneva convention relating to the status of refugees

when the birth of fascist ideology was first published in 1989 in france and at the beginning of 1993 in italy it aroused a storm of response positive and negative to zeev sternhell s controversial interpretations in sternhell s view fascism was much more than an episode in the history of italy he argues here that it possessed a coherent ideology with deep roots in european civilization long before fascism became a political force he maintains it was a major cultural phenomenon this important book further asserts that although fascist ideology was grounded in a revolt against the enlightenment it was not a reactionary movement it represented instead an ideological alternative to marxism and liberalism and competed effectively with them by positing a revolt against modernity sternhell argues that the conceptual framework of fascism played an important role in its development building on radical nationalism and an antimaterialist revision of marxism fascism sought to destroy the existing political order and to uproot its theoretical and moral foundations at the same time its proponents wished to preserve all the achievements of modern technology and the advantages of the market economy nevertheless fascism opposed every bourgeois value universalism humanism progress natural rights and equality thus as sternhell shows the fascists adopted the

economic aspect of liberalism but completely denied its philosophical principles and the intellectual and moral heritage of modernity
